As His followers, we have the distinct privilege of living out the true meaning of Christmas every day of the year. That is our mission at Mars Hill, to be used of God to help people everywhere experience the birth of His life in their lives now! We do that by making The HOPE movie, the grand story of the Gospel from creation through eternity, available in as many ways, to as many people, in as many places as possible. Here are some of the ways we've done that in 2013 . . .

The HOPE, an evangelism and discipleship tool used by harvest workers and Church planters around the world.

What does a post-modern city dweller in Europe have in common with an unreached people group in India? Most likely, neither has any reference point for basic Biblical concepts such as the power of sin or a loving, all-powerful Creator. This often makes it difficult for either to follow a simple "four spiritual laws" type of Gospel presentation, or to truly understand what it means to follow Jesus as the God,

instead of just another god.

Like this showing in Haiti, The HOPE is used in villages worldwide. One ministry partner in Haiti has seen over 687 decisions for Christ after HOPE viewings in 2013.

movie, or in chapters over a period of time. It could be on a university campus with highly educated international students or in a remote jungle village with people who don't read. With nearly a million copies in circulation, the kinds of

situations and places in which The HOPE is being used are simply too many to list.

Broadcasting HOPE - In various regions, The HOPE is now broadcast regularly in several languages including Arabic, French, Mandarin, Thai, German, Russian, Spanish, and English. We are particularly excited about broadcasts into areas that are hostile to the Great Good News of the Gospel.

HOPE on the Internet - Nearly 10 years ago, not long after the completion of the English version of The HOPE, one of our ministry partners, Christian Answers.net, began streaming The HOPE online. Soon after that, Gospel Communications (the Bible Gateway people) partnered with us on a website dedicated to The HOPE. Our

French partners have been conducting an online discipleship course with The HOPE for years. From these and other online ministries we know of thousands of people who have come to Christ and grown in their faith. We praise God for this ministry, but we believe the best is yet to come!

There are now over 2 billion people around the world using the Internet. This year we launched a new website which is making The HOPE video, a study guide and a means for follow-up available in the languages spoken by nearly 90% of the entire worldwide
